


Need to see a GP in the evening or at weekends?





We are now offering appointments with NHS GPs over video through our partners, LIVI, whose app is free to download. You can chose to book a video appointment with a LIVI GP or enter a drop-in queue where most patients are seen within 30 minutes.

Please speak to our Reception Team to get the sign-up link so you can get going. All you need is a smartphone or tablet and some photo ID for the initial registration. There is also a patient helpline on the app if you need any further assistance in getting set up.







We are currently offering appointments for patients requiring the flu vaccination.

- If you have a heart, kidney or liver disease, diabetes, asthma or COPD or are aged 65 you are entitled to a free flu vaccine.
- If you are pregnant please contact your midwife who will arrange this for you
- Nasal Flu—all those aged 2 and 3 (but not 4 years or older) on 31st August 2019 are entitled to have a vaccination. Please note:- these cannot be given on the Saturday clinics. Please contact us for available dates.
- ◆ ALL flu vaccines are by appointment only—please speak to out Reception Team who will be more than happy to book you in.

A Note from our Dispensary

Please do not ask for more than 1 months supply of your medications as we will be unable to help you. You are welcome to order your medication slightly early to ensure you have plenty to cover holiday periods. If you need a prescription please allow at least 3 working days for the request to be processed. This can be done via the website, by letter, by completing the repeat slip or a form at our dispensary.

Be aware that our dispensary runs at minimum staffing levels between the hours of 12pm and 2pm. Therefore, we kindly request that ALL NON URGENT telephone queries are made AFTER 2pm. Thank you for your cooperation .

If you have any medication queries you will be directed to our pharmacy team without having to speak directly to a doctor.



SICK NOTE REQUESTS

We are getting an increasing number of sick note requests on the day. The GPs do not consider these requests to be urgent as sick notes can be back-dated if necessary. Please give as much notice as possible. Remember, you must do a self-certification for the first 7 days of illness, there is no requirement for a GP to write a sick note for less than 7 days illness.

Minor Eye Conditions Service (MECS)

This is a service to our patients who have minor eye conditions which do not require an appointment at the Medical Centre.

Please ring the above number and they will arrange an appointment for you if you have any of the following conditions:-

- Red eye or eyelids with no loss of vision
- Dry eye or gritty or itchy uncomfortable eyes
- Mild ocular pain which improves slightly with pain killers
- Irritation and inflammation of the eye
- In growing eyelashes
- Significant recent sticky discharge from eye or watery eye
- Recently occurring flashes or floaters for less than 3 months with no loss of vision
- Recent change or distortion of vision for more than 48 hours with no pain
